SEPTEMBER 15: SPEAK OUT TO SAVE THE HIGH LINE AT THE WEST SIDE RAIL YARDS

On Monday, September 15, come to the first public viewing of the revised plans for the West Side Rail Yards, and show that you support full preservation of the High Line. The Related Companies, the developer that was selected by the MTA in May 2008, has revised its proposal and will make a comprehensive presentation, including the proposed treatment of the High Line on the site.

This will be your first opportunity to see the new proposal and give feedback. As High Line supporters, it will be our chance to tell the developer how strongly we feel about preserving the final 1/3 of the High Line- the only section which is not yet protected from demolition. As the process moves forward, Friends of the High Line will continue to advocate for full preservation of the historic High Line structure on the site. Please join us to make sure our voices are heard.
